StageSong (FALL). Taught by Casis teacher Kevin Dunn, open to **grades 1-5**, meeting Wednesday afternoons by age level. Students study singing basics through a repertoire of secular holiday tunes, including both novelty and traditional numbers. All music is arranged/composed by Mr. Dunn to suit the needs of the students. In addition to the more serious numbers, a StageSong tradition, the "Pie in the Face" song, ends with a marshmallow creme "event."

Costume requirements. These are minimal (black pants, athletic shoes), as a screen print t-shirt of the show theme is included in tuition costs.

Combined Wednesday rehearsal meets at **2:45--3:45 for grades 1-2 (Basic)** and **2:45--4:15 for grades 3-5 (Advanced)** from **Sept. 2 through Oct. 28. On Wednesday, Nov. 4, all students stay until 4:15 to receive t-shirts. On Thursday, Nov. 5, students arrive to rehearse at 5:00 p.m. and the PERFORMANCE follows at 6:30 p.m.--7:00 p.m. PLEASE KEEP A COPY OF THIS SCHEDULE FOR THE SEMESTER!**

Additionally, younger siblings can remain in rehearsal room, **Music Portable P-B**, while older siblings complete the more advanced work. This program is great fun for kids and is an easy way to become comfortable on a stage. Younger students sing in choral formation; older students may be given solos or small ensembles, as needed. Cougar Chorus (SPRING). Taught by Casis teacher Kevin Dunn, follows a format similar to the fall StageSong classes. Rehearsals run from January through mid-March and allow students of varying ages to enjoy performances. Repertoire often includes a unique mix of musical materials, such as a pairing of folk music with jazz standards or light pop music with patriotic standards. Based on the age and experience level of the group, more advanced harmony may be employed.
